## WHAT IS MEDIATION?

Mediation is a conflict resolution process in which a third party facilitates communication and negotiation to help parties come to a mutually acceptable agreement. The mediator does not take sides or decide how the dispute should be resolved. Mediators in foreclosure mediations are also required to communicate with the Court regarding compliance with Vermont's Foreclosure Mediation Statute.

You were provided with a list of three trained mediators for your review and selection. Further information about each mediator is available <u>HERE</u>. When reviewing please consider this list of Foreclosure Mediators from the Vermont Bar Association and consider the experience and availability of the mediators. You should decide who you feel most comfortable working with and communicate that to counsel for the other party.
