What is Law Day? Law Day, held annually on May 1 (although any day can be "Law Day"), is a national day set aside to celebrate the rule of law. Law Day provides an opportunity to understand how law and the legal process protect American liberty, strive to achieve justice, and contribute to the freedoms that all Americans share. The American Bar Association establishes a theme and provides education resources every year. The 2025 Theme is: "The Constitution's Promise: Out of Many, One."

The Constitution enshrines our collective responsibility to one another, and the 2025 Law Day theme urges us to take pride in a Constitution that bridges our differences to bring us together as a united nation. Our civic lives tie us together as one "We," whether through legislative efforts that serve the common good, through military service, or by working together, every day, to fulfill the promise of E pluribus unum, or "Out of many, one."
